



TEE TIME RESERVATIONS

Online Bookings

Full payment is required to secure the booking.

Bookings made through Office

A 50% non-refundable deposit is required to secure the booking. A provisional enquiry will be held for 14 days after which the tee time will be released unless a deposit has been paid. The Balance payment is required on or before the date of play.

Refunds / Cancellation

Cancellations received will result in the forfeiture of the deposit. We regret that we cannot offer refunds or future credit due to delayed/cancelled flights, travel plans, personal injury, or illness. For this reason, we strongly recommend that you have travel insurance to cover this eventuality.

Alteration of Booking

Up to 14 days before the day of play, tee times can be moved to an alternative date within a year of the original booking (subject to availability). Should the green fee rate increase the difference will need to be paid.

Adverse Weather

If you are unable to complete your round of golf due to the course closure, you will be entitled to re-book. If the course is open and you decide not to play no refund will be given.

Tee Time Arrangements

Please note that when making a booking, the tee time arrangements are such that you may be playing behind or ahead of golfers in 4-ball groups. It is important to understand this when booking, as it may affect the pace of play and overall experience on the course.

Winter and Shoulder Rates

Please be aware that our golf course may be subject to necessary maintenance procedures during the winter and shoulder rate seasons. While we strive to minimise disruptions, some maintenance activities may temporarily impact the condition of certain areas of the course.

DRESS CODE

Please make your entire group aware of our Dress Rules both on the course and in the clubhouse to save potential embarrassment or problems on the day.
